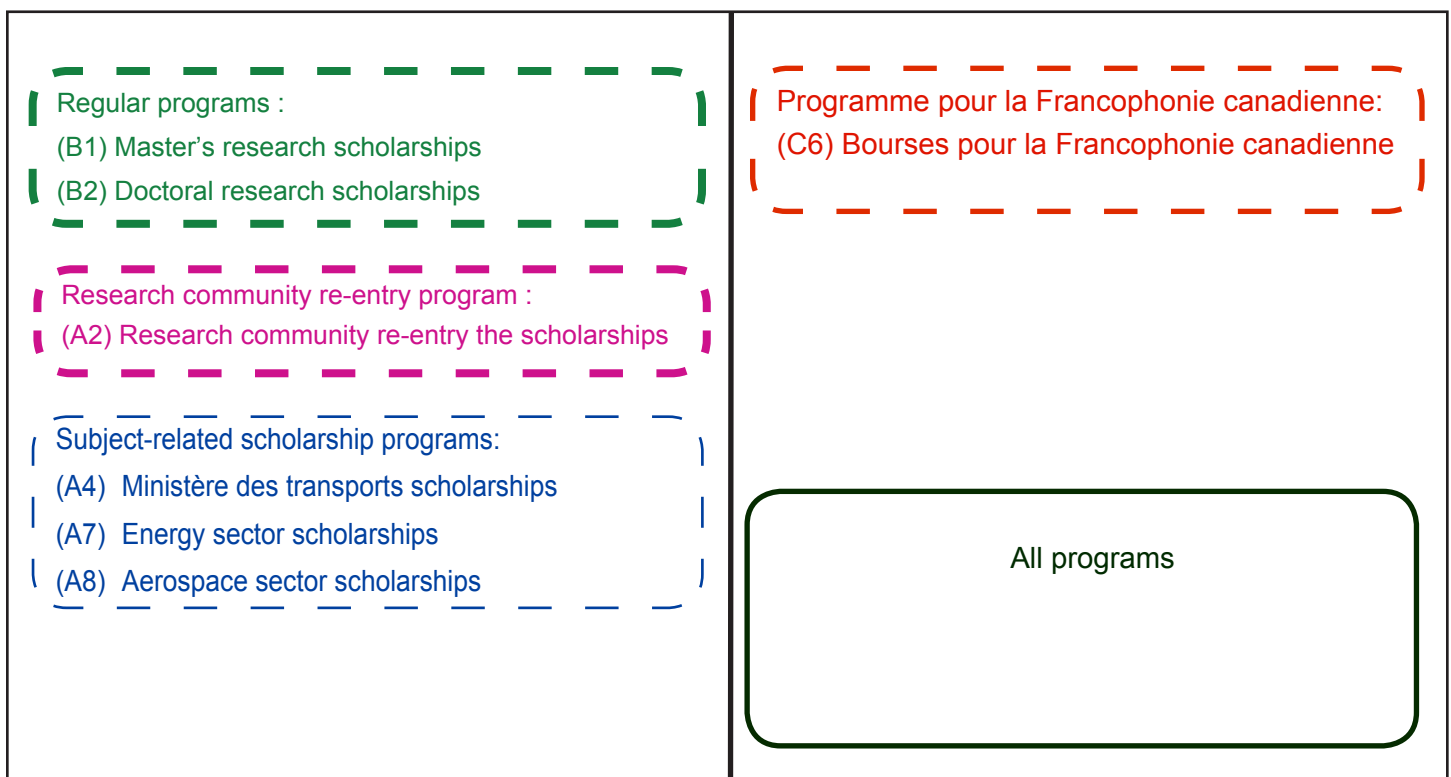

- 2- A proof of successful completion of the thesis defence and a copy of the document attesting the thesis' final submission. In the absence of such documents, a copy of doctoral transcripts (B3).
- 3- For those who have completed their Master's degree, a copy of the diploma (Q1 only).
- 4- Acknowledgements of receipt and notifications from the editor for all submitted articles (B1, B2, B3, A2, A4, A7, A8, C6, CL, Q1, RD).
